Subject: Opening of a position in spinal orthopedic surgery.

The orthopedic division of the CHUS (CIUSSS de l'Estrie-CHUS) is actually looking for a position in spinal orthopedic surgery starting January 2017.

The candidate must hold a medical degree and be eligible for an orthopedic surgery license in the province of Quebec and a satisfactory mastery of spoken and written French language.

The candidate should have, or expect to acquire, additional fellowship training of at least 12 months in complex spinal surgery. Expertise in minimally invasive spine surgery would be an asset.

The CHUS is a tertiary center for spinal surgery, with a population base for referral of more than 500 000 inhabitants, covering traumatic, degenerative, infectious and tumor spinal pathologies. The candidate will join a team of 4 other spinal surgeons (2 orthopedic surgeons and 2 neurosurgeons) and participate in the coverage of the call schedule in spinal surgery one week out of five.

As member of the orthopedic residency program, selected candidate will join a team of 14 other orthopedic surgeons to participate in teaching to residents of the orthopedic program and other residency programs, as well as medical students from the University of Sherbrooke. The candidate must then have a real interest and a profile for academic practice. Research interest will also be taken into account.
