



MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION PROCESS: Fellow / Resident Membership
Fellows and Residents enrolled in accredited spine program within Canada

DEFINITION:

The Canadian Spine Society is offering membership to anyone participating as a fellow or resident in an accredited spine program within Canada. The Fellow / Resident rate will be continued for as long as the member is part of the program. The request for membership must be accompanied by a letter from the Program Director or supervisor and should include the date the fellowship or residency started and its duration.

ANNUAL DUES: Resident / Fellow membership dues will be set at \$125 annually. The membership term runs from January 1 through to December 31 of each year. Members are invoiced for dues after January 1 annually. Payment should be remitted within 30 days.

To apply simply submit the following documents via **email**:

- An electronic copy of your current CV
